

By completing this application form, Exhibitor is applying for tabletop exhibit space at OGGB/TEXAS NORML's Texas Cannabis Crusade ("Show"), to be held in Austin, TX on May 1, 2010, and agrees to abide by rules and regulations set forth by OGGB/TEXAS NORML ("Management"). Processing of payment does not constitute acceptance, nor guaranteed space availability. Payment will be refunded by OGGB if Applicant is not accepted or space is not available.

Exhibit fee payment must be received in full before April 1, 2010. Payment methods accepted include AMEX, Discover, MasterCard and Visa. **No Purchase Orders will be accepted.** The fee (\$200/commercial table; \$150/non-profit table) entitles exhibiting company to one 10 ft. X 10 ft. space, company listing in printed schedules (if contracted before printing deadline) and two exhibit staff name badges. You will be responsible for any tables, tents or chairs that you may need. Electricity is available for a nominal fee.

An Exhibitor may cancel its participation in Show by giving Management notice in writing. If Management receives notice of cancellation by the close of business on **April, 20th 2010**, the Exhibitor will receive a refund, minus a cancellation charge of 50%. If notice of cancellation is received after that time, no refund will be given. Any Exhibitor failing to occupy space contracted for on **Saturday, May 1st, 2010**, will be considered in default and is subject to cancellation. In the event of cancellation, Management has the right to use the space for its own convenience, including selling the space to another exhibitor, without rebate or allowance to the canceled Exhibitor. OGGB/TEXAS NORML assumes no responsibility for having included the name or description of the canceled Exhibitor in programs or other material.

OGGB/TEXAS NORML will not knowingly accept advertisements, sponsorship or exhibitors that discriminate on the basis of ethnic group, race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age and/or disability.

Use of Space: It is agreed that Exhibitor shall not assign, share or sublet any part of the exhibit space without the express written consent of Management. Exhibitor releases OGGB/TEXAS NORML and its representatives from any and all liability for damages or loss caused by fire, police interference, theft or any unforeseen circumstances that arise while exhibiting at this event. Exhibitors are responsible to take all reasonable care to protect themselves from loss or damage. In the event the event facility is destroyed or damaged, or if the show fails to take place as scheduled, or is interrupted and/or discontinued, or access to the premises is prevented by reasons of strike, lockout, injunction, act of God, act of war, emergency declared by any government agency or by OGGB/TEXAS NORML, or for any other reason, this contract may be terminated by OGGB/TEXAS NORML. In the event of such termination, Exhibitor waives any and all damages and claims for damages and agrees that the sole liability for OGGB/TEXAS NORML shall be to return each Exhibitor its space payment, less its prorated share of all costs and expenses incurred and committed by OGGB/TEXAS NORML.

Exhibitors shall arrange their displays to use only within the 10X10 booth area under contract, and in such a manner as to recognize the rights of other exhibitors and Attendees. Distribution of pamphlets, brochures or advertising is welcomed throughout the festival grounds. Exhibitor will limit its activities to the contracted booth space. The

operation of sound movies or audio devices will be permitted only if sound level is kept at conversational level and is not objectionable to neighboring exhibitors. Audio and video machines must be positioned so that Attendees will not block walkways. Machines that create noise and/or disrupt neighboring exhibits may, at the discretion of Management, be restricted.

The Exhibitor is responsible for maintaining a neat appearance to its display. Exhibitor must arrange for the removal of excess trash and waste materials and is responsible to keep the exhibit free of any and all conditions that might be dangerous to Attendees.

Trash and recycling bins will be located at each corner of the festival grounds.

Products and/or services on display in the exhibit area carry no implied or real endorsement or recommendation by OGGB/TEXAS NORML. Exhibitor agrees that it will not represent any product or service as being endorsed by OGGB/TEXAS NORML. OGGB/TEXAS NORML reserve the right to prohibit any exhibit or any part of an exhibit at its sole discretion.

All matters and questions that arise which are not specifically covered by these Rules and Regulations are subject to the decision of Management. The Rules and Regulations may be amended, added to, and amplified by Management at their discretion. Exhibitor agrees to abide by any and all amendments and changes by Management. It is understood that the agreement between Exhibitor and Management is fully and entirely expressed in this contract, and that there are no oral or verbal agreements of any kind whereby the Rules and Regulations of this contract are or can be changed or modified in any way prior to the close of the show. Now with all that out of the way, please be sure to enjoy yourselves as much as possible during this event. Remember to drink plenty of water and stay in the shade. Most importantly, thank you for your interest in this event, and we hope to have you back again next year.

Payment must be received in full by **APRIL 1st**. Payment method accepted by AMEX, Discover, MasterCard or Visa. No Purchase Orders will be accepted.
